


**Trent to open seven hypermarkets this year**

Tata Group's retail arm Trent will open seven hypermarkets this year as part of its plan to add 50 hypermarkets in the next three years, a top company official said. The expansion of Star Bazaar, the hypermarket format which sells food and grocery, will require an investment of Rs 275 crore, P Venkatesalu, CFO of Trent told reporters after the company's AGM in Mumbai. **Karur Vysya eyes Rs 50,000-cr biz, 100 new branches in FY'12**

Karur Vysya Bank (KVB) will be applying for 100 new branches in the next fiscal (FY 12) to meet its total business target of Rs 50,000 crore by then from the present Rs 35,000 crore, an official said. "We will be applying to the RBI for 70-100 new branch licences in 2011-12," KVB Managing Director P T Kuppuswamy (ET)

**Greaves Cotton to set up Rs 100-cr plant in Aurangabad**

Greaves Cotton, plans to build an automotive engine manufacturing plant in Aurangabad for about Rs 100 crore, to meet growing demand for such engines, said a senior executive. "An initial investment of Rs 60 crore has already been made in the unit which will have the capacity to produce 80,000 engines annually," said managing director Prabhakar Dev. Greaves Cotton, that has interests in construction equipment, industrial engines and automotive engines, plans to start production from the new plant by the end of fiscal 2011. (ET)

**Blackstone powers Moser Baer's plans**

Private equity investor Blackstone has picked up a minority stake Moser Baer Projects for Rs 1,350 crore that will help the privately held firm set up several power projects in India. Moser Baer Projects is owned by the promoters of CD-DVD maker Moser Baer India, who have been trying to diversify their group's business beyond optical storage products. The fund raised from Blackstone will be used for part financing its power projects that are under implementation and requires as much as Rs 30,000 crore. (Bloomberg)

**Bajaj Corp plans foray into non-haircare segments, eyes buys**

Bajaj Corp Limited, a leading FMCG company with major brands in the haircare category, is planning to enter four non-haircare segments through both the organic and inorganic routes, a top company official said. "We have plans to enter four non-haircare segments and are mulling possibilities, both organic and inorganic.

**Dr Reddy's scouting for partners in Japan**

Drug maker Dr Reddy's Laboratories said it was looking out for partnerships to expand its presence in Japan. The company, which was also recently speculated for a possible stake sale by the promoters denied any such move. "Yes, we are looking at Japan and we are looking for partnerships," Dr Reddy's, Managing Director and COO Satish Reddy told reporters here on the sidelines of a CII function. (ET)

**Suven Life to raise \$20 mn by fiscal-end to fund trials**

Pharmaceutical company Suven Life Sciences on Wednesday said it will raise \$20 million before the end of this fiscal to fund clinical trials of one of its molecules aimed at treating Alzheimer's disease. "Currently, we have 13 molecules that are aimed for treating central nervous system disorders. One molecule code named '502' has completed the first phase of trials. "We are looking to enter the second phase of trials by 2011 for which we will require about \$20 million," Suven Life Sciences Chairman and CEO Venkat Jasti told. (ET)

**Centre's GST roll out plan hits BJP roadblock**

The centre's proposal to introduce Constitution Amendment Bill in the current Parliament session to pave the way for rolling out the Goods and Service Tax (GST) hit a road block, with the BJP-ruled states demanding more time to respond to the draft. "The states have got hardly two working days to examine the revised draft and take a decision thereon...," Madhya Pradesh Finance Minister Raghawji said at the states GST panel meeting here. "I have been wondering the reason for the rush to implement the GST as if the country is passing through a severe financial crisis and GST is the panacea for all the ills," Raghawji added. (ET)

**Pranab sees 30% shortfall in infra funding in 12th Plan**

Finance Minister Pranab Mukherjee has said there may be 30 per cent gap in infrastructure funding requirement, targetted at Rs 41 lakh crore, in the 12th Five Year Plan (2012-2017). "There may be a substantial gap of up to 30 per cent in financing the ambitious target of (Rs) 41 lakh crore of investment in infrastructure for the XII Plan," Mukherjee said. He said the fundamental constraint in financing infrastructure relates to the limits on banks' lending to the sector due to asset-liability mismatch. The funds are required for 14-15 years but deposits are of shorter maturity, he added. (ET)

**FDI in services sector dips by 28.19 pc**

The government said foreign direct investment inflows in the services sector in 2009-10 dipped by 28.19 per cent to USD 4.39 billion. The sector had attracted FDI worth USD 6.11 billion 2008-09. However, inflows in the sector, including financial and non-financial services were highest in comparison to other segments, State Minister for Commerce and Industry Jyotiraditya Scindia said. Of the USD 4.39 billion FDI, about USD 1.99 billion came from Singapore. (ET)

**Malaysia's Growth Holds Near Decade High, May Exceed Forecast**

Malaysia's economy grew near the fastest pace in a decade in the second quarter, an expansion that may prompt the central bank to consider raising interest rates further. Gross domestic product increased 8.9 percent in the three months through June from a year earlier, after expanding 10.1 percent in the first quarter, the central bank said. Growth may exceed 6 percent this year, Governor Zeti Akhtar Aziz said. Malaysia's central bank has raised interest rates three times this year, and policy makers will deliberate in two weeks if the economy is strong enough to withstand higher borrowing costs as threats to the world recovery grow. (Bloomberg)

**Biggest U.S. Banks May Face \$180 Billion in Loan Repurchases, Fitch Says**

Bank of America Corp., JPMorgan Chase & Co., Citigroup Inc. and Wells Fargo & Co. might face demands to repurchase as much as \$180 billion of troubled mortgages from Fannie Mae and Freddie Mac, Fitch Ratings said. At the end of June, the two government-sponsored loan guarantors held a total of \$355 billion of troubled mortgages in their portfolios, of which half were serviced by the four banks, the largest in the U.S., Fitch wrote in a report. (Bloomberg)

**U.S. MBA Mortgage Applications Index Rose 13% Last Week on Refinancing**

The number of mortgage applications in the U.S. increased last week, propelled by a surge in refinancing as borrowing costs hovered near record lows. The Mortgage Bankers Association's index rose 13 percent in the week ended Aug. 13, the Washington-based group said. Refinancing jumped 17 percent to reach the highest level since May 2009, while purchases fell 3.4 percent. The drop in rates that is prompting Americans to lower monthly payments, is doing little to spur sales as unemployment holds close to a 26-year high. (Bloomberg)

**New Zealand Second-Quarter Producer Input Prices Rise 1.4%**

Prices paid by New Zealand farms, factories and other producers for commodities and services needed to run their businesses rose in the second quarter, led by crude oil, livestock and milk. Producer input prices gained 1.4 percent from the first quarter, Statistics New Zealand said in Wellington today. From a year earlier, they advanced 2 percent. Input prices rose for a third consecutive quarter as a global recovery buoyed demand for commodities. Livestock prices were boosted by a drought in some regions, the agency said. (Bloomberg)
