


**MARKET PREVIEW**

Asia stocks fell, dragging the MSCI Asia Pacific Index down for a third day, as share-sale plans at Japanese companies raised concern the value of existing holdings will be reduced.

U.S. stocks slipped, pulling the Standard & Poor's 500 Index down from a 13-month high, as technology companies slid after profit forecasts at Autodesk Inc. and Salesforce.com Inc. trailed some analyst estimates.

The index has rallied as much as 64 percent from a 12-year low in March, pushing its valuation to about 22 times its companies' reported earnings from continuing operations, the highest level since 2002, weekly data compiled by Bloomberg show.

The dollar dropped against the euro and the Dollar Index, which gauges the currency against six major U.S. trading partners, retreated 0.4 percent. Oil advanced after the government reported that crude supplies unexpectedly decreased. Oil for delivery next month rose 0.6 percent to \$79.58 a barrel in New York.

Residential construction in the U.S. unexpectedly dropped in October amid concern a homebuyer tax credit would expire, illustrating the market's dependence on government help to sustain a recovery as job losses mount.

Builders broke ground on 529,000 houses at an annual pace, down 11 percent from the prior month and the fewest since April's record low, Commerce Department figures showed today in Washington.

Homebuilding seized up as builders waited for President Barack Obama to extend a first-time buyer incentive, which has since been passed and expanded. The highest unemployment rate in 26 years and consumer prices that remain below Fed long-term goals indicate policy makers will need to nurture the economy by keeping interest rates near zero.

Obama and Congress this month extended a tax credit of as much as \$8,000 for first-time homebuyers until April 30, from Nov. 30. They also expanded it to include some current owners.

Steel production in China, the world's largest maker and consumer, may outpace demand growth this year, spurring exports in the last two months, the China Iron & Steel Association said. Output may rise to a higher-than-expected 565 mn metric tons, and demand may gain 18% to 549 mn tons, Vice Chairman Luo Bingsheng said today in Beijing. Rising Chinese supply will depress prices and spur exports that will compete with regional mills including Nippon Steel Corp. Baoshan Iron & Steel Co., China's largest steelmaker, this month said falling prices will affect fourth-quarter profit and it plans to curb output through annual maintenance.

**JSW Steel may sell minority stake to foreign co for around Rs 2k cr**

JSW Steel is close to entering into a strategic alliance with a global steel company that could see the foreign firm buying a minority stake and offering technology to help India's third-largest steel maker make speciality steel products, two people close to the matter said. The Sajjan Jindal-controlled firm would issue fresh shares, amounting to about 5-10% of its equity, to the foreign company, according to one of them. Such a stake sale could fetch JSW between Rs 1,000 to Rs 2,000 crore. (ET)

**Sun Pharma subsi gets USFDA nod for anti-hypertension drug**

Drug firm Sun Pharmaceutical Industries on Wednesday said that its subsidiary, has received US Drug regulator approval for anti-hypertension drug. The subsidiary has received the US Food and Drug Administration (USFDA) approval for Niacardipine Hydrochloride injections, available in the strength of 25 mg/10ml, Sun Pharmaceutical said in a filing to the Bombay Stock Exchange. The injections are used for short-term treatment of hypertension when oral therapy is not feasible, the filing added. (ET)

**Suzlon opens wind farm in Australia**

Wind energy major Suzlon Energy has officially opened Infigen Energy's Capital wind farm, the largest wind farm in Australia at Bungendore in New South Wales. The 67-turbine wind farm, located near Australia's capital Canberra, was delivered by Suzlon through a turnkey contract that covered engineering, procurement and construction. The farm will produce 141 Megawatt (Mw) of energy, according to a press release. Infigen Energy, formerly known as Babcock and Brown Wind Partners Group, is an Australia-based company with wind energy assets in Australia, United States, Germany and France. "The Capital wind farm is an important milestone towards Australia's commitment to making the transition to a low carbon economy and I welcome the Australian government's ongoing support for renewable energy," Suzlon Energy Chairman Tulsi Tanti said. (BS)

**Petronet may acquire up to 10% stake in OPaL**

Liquefied gas importer Petronet LNG (PLL) is keen to acquire up to 10% stake in ONGC Petro-additions (OPaL), the special purpose vehicle formed for setting up a chemical complex at Dahej SEZ. "Petronet LNG has shown interest to acquire up to 10 % stake in OPaL. The board will take a decision on the matter," ONGC told. The company is also looking to hit the capital market in the next fiscal, but is yet to decide on the amount of stake to be made public, he said. "We are certainly looking at an IPO for OPaL and it is up to the board to decide how much would be offloaded. The IPO is likely to happen next year," Balyan said. ONGC holds 26 % stake in OPaL, while 5% stake is with GSPC. ONGC has agreed to sell 19% stake in OPaL to GAIL. (BS)

**Govt says has tools to manage heavy inflows**

India would have the tools ready to deal with an influx of foreign capital inflows if they become disruptive, Finance Minister told. With Western economies still crawling out of recession and interest rates at or near historic lows, funds have been flooding into faster-growing Asian markets. Indian officials had said on recent occasions that they welcomed fund inflows, but Mukherjee on Wednesday also noted that India is ready to deal with the flows if they become a problem. "It is not a matter of concern as we have the system of monitoring," he told reporters. "And whenever we will find that there are some distortion, then we will have the arrangement to counteract it," he said on the sidelines of an event. (ET)

**Insurance, banking bills unlikely in Winter session**

Major financial sector bills such as the Insurance Law Amendment Bill seeking to increase the FDI cap in private insurance firms and the Banking Regulation Amendment Bill to raise the voting rights of foreign entities in private sector banks are unlikely to be taken up in the Winter session of Parliament that begins tomorrow. However, the Constitutional Amendment Bill seek to roll out Goods and Services Tax (GST) and the Direct Taxes Code Bill may be tabled in the session that ends on December 21. The government will reintroduce the Pension Reforms Bill which seeks to give statutory powers to the interim sectoral regulator PFRDA and open up the sector, Parliamentary Affairs Minister PK Bansal told reporters here today. (ET)

**NHAI slashes number of projects for FY11 to 92**

The National Highways Authority of India (NHAI), having failed to meet the deadline for awarding 126 projects during the current financial year, has brought down the number of projects to be awarded in the next financial year to 92. The authority, in its work plan for the financial year 2010-11, has planned to award 92 projects, covering 11,721 km and worth over Rs 1 lakh crore. During Work Plan-I for the financial year 2009-10, NHAI planned to award 126 projects, covering 11,928 km and worth Rs 1 lakh crore. The authority would not be able to award all the projects by March 2010 and the stipulated period for this has been extended by three months to June 2010. (BS)

**Shipping min seeks to up goods traffic along coastal areas, inland waterways**

To promote transport of goods along the coastline of the country and on national waterways, the Ministry of Shipping has written to the Ministry of Finance to exempt goods transported through such routes from service tax. A senior official at the shipping ministry said: "Though transportation of goods through inland waterways and coastal routes is energy-efficient, cost-effective and environment-friendly, traffic has remained low on such routes. We are undertaking measures to boost traffic through these means. At this time, the imposition of the proposed service tax would be a burden on customers and discourage interested users." (BS)

**China Sovereign Fund Buys \$710 Mn Stake in GCL-Poly Energy**

China Investment Corp. bought a HK\$5.5 bn (\$710 mn) stake in a Hong Kong-based solar power component maker as the sovereign wealth fund invests in energy and commodities companies to hedge against inflation. The Chinese fund will have a 20% stake in GCL-Poly Energy Holdings Ltd. and the two companies agreed to set up a venture to invest in solar power projects, according a stock exchange filing in Hong Kong yesterday. GCL-Poly jumped as much as 20%, the most since June 23, when it resumed trading in Hong Kong today after a three-day suspension. CIC, which held almost \$300 bn in assets at the end of last year, is seeking resources from Indonesia to Canada to support expansion in the world's fastest-growing major economy. (Bloomberg)

**Singapore Says Economy May Expand 3% to 5% Next Year**

Singapore said its economy will expand next year after exiting the deepest recession since independence in 1965, adding to evidence of a regional recovery that's prompted some policy makers to start removing stimulus. The economy will grow 3% to 5% in 2010 after shrinking as much as 2.5% this year, the trade ministry said in a statement today. Gross domestic product climbed a revised annualized 14.2% last quarter from the previous three months, the second consecutive expansion, it said. (Bloomberg)

**Oil Trades Near \$80 After Drop in U.S. Crude, Fuel Stockpiles**

Oil traded near \$80 a barrel in New York after rising yesterday as a government report showed U.S. crude and fuel supplies dropped along with refinery production and imports. Crude oil gained 0.6% yesterday and touched \$80.33 after the Energy Department said crude inventories declined 887,000 barrels to 336.8 mn last week. Stockpiles were forecast to increase by 300,000 barrels, according to a Bloomberg News survey of analysts. Fuel supplies fell as refiners operated at the slowest pace in more than a year. (Bloomberg)

**GM, Chrysler not required to make electric cars: Bloom**

The Obama administration's preference for robust electric car production will not influence its oversight of taxpayer equity in General Motors and Chrysler, an administration official said. Ron Bloom, the head of the government task force that facilitated the restructuring of GM and Chrysler this year, said in an interview with Reuters that there is a bright line separating the two issues. We obviously would be very happy if Chrysler and GM were making lots and lots of high mileage cars. It's not a prerequisite. It's not an obligation," Bloom said on Tuesday. (ET)
